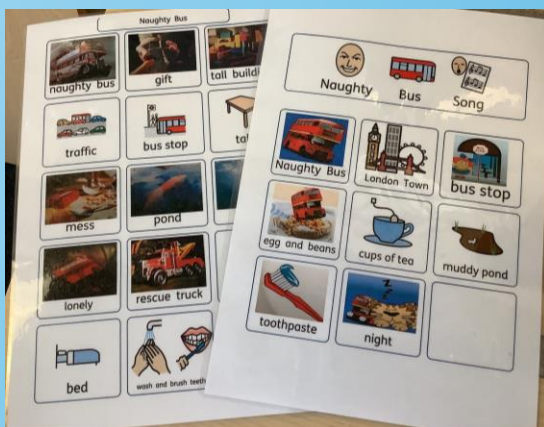


## NEWSLETTER - 15.5.26
